FROM YOUR PASTOR

Lest we forget . . .

Hebrews 2:1 says, "Therefore we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we drift away." As your pastor I want to remind all of us of something we have been taught through the years that we must diligently guard during these most unusual moments in history. It has to do with the church. Many have made statements that the building may be closed but that the "church" is still open. The statement reminds us that the church is not the building. This is a true statement but on the other hand we must be careful that we do not fail to remember what the church is during this time that much has been paused in reference to the ministry of the church. The word church in the New Testament is a word that means the "called out assembly." The church is the "called out" which means it is a group of people that have been saved, radically transformed and Jesus followers. It is also an "assembly" of called out, radically saved Jesus followers. The church is not a Christian or a family sitting at home watching a sermon on TV or the internet. We must remember that these weeks that we have had to sacrifice our gathering together is not a permanent, acceptable plan because it is not church. The church is the called-out assembly gathered for the purpose of worshipping the Father together, observing the ordinances of the Lord's Supper and Baptism, fellowshipping, prayer, giving and breaking of bread together. It is the place of accountability among the members and the setting aside of men to the role of deacons and pastors. The church is the body gathered for the purpose of ministry to those in

need and serving together in fulfilling the Great Com-

mission. These matters can only be done by the church gathered in one accord in one place. Let us be cautious to guard ourselves from complacency, getting at ease in Zion as Amos 6:1 warns and redefining the church from our present experiences or personal comforts.

A few updates in references to cancellations and the restart of ministry. Our Alaska Mission Trip, VBS, Children's Summer Program, Summer Camps for Youth and Children, GA Camp and the Erwin Family Concert have all been canceled. The Family Life Center will reopen on Monday, June 1 with a few adjustments. We will allow walking and weightlifting but there will be no basketball or game room activities until further notice. We will also not open on Wednesday afternoons or Saturday. Our mid -week bible study and prayer meeting will restart on Wednesday, June 17 at 6:45pm. We will examine the restart of Sunday School and Sunday evening services the first of July. The Youth Committee and Children's Committee are working on decisions concerning the Youth Gathering, Children's Church, Childcare, Team Kid and Van Ministry. The Word for the Kids will continue each Wednesday at 6:00pm on Facebook Live. Hope to see you on the Lord's Day at either 9:00am or 11:00am.


