Thanks be to God!

Why did the Lord allow I Thessalonians 5:18 into the canon of Scripture!? "In <u>everything</u> give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." There are times, many times, that I fail to fulfill this verse. I know it does not say give thanks *for* all things but *in* everything. I also know this means that I can give thanks that God is Sovereign even when my situation is dire and discouraging. We have certainly been amid difficult situations this year that makes practicing this verse a challenge. Well, we only have one good choice, do it! Join with me in this final month of 2020 by practicing this command daily. We will benefit mightily if we do. Now for some easy words of giving thanks:

Thank you for blessing the Seth York family with a special offering of over \$2,600 as they have been on furlough from their position at Crossings Camp the past five months.

Thank you for blessing several families and holiday workers with upwards of 200 meals on Thanksgiving Day. Thank you for surpassing our record with 1,221 shoeboxes packed for Operation Christmas Child.

Now for the difficult news that still requires a thankful heart. Our ministerial staff and deacons have decided on the following protocol that will continue till January 1. We will continue in-person worship each Sunday at 9:00am and 11:00am with Live Streaming of the 11:00am service. We will cancel Sunday School, Sunday evening services, and the 11:00am Nursery until January 1. The Wednesday mid-week service will be canceled till Wednesday, December 16 when we will meet at 6:45pm for a special prayer service and our end of year business meeting. We will continue to maintain physical distancing by taping off every other pew and masks will be strongly encouraged when entering and departing the building and when physical distancing cannot be maintained. The wearing of a mask will not be mandated once sitting on a pew, but it is completely acceptable to wear even when seated. Much thought is going into these matters as it relates to our church corporately and as we consider the many opinions individually. Let us not only give thanks *in* this time but above all demonstrate grace, love, and kindness toward one another as family.

Back to the easy thanksgiving. Thanks be to God for His marvelous grace and wonderful salvation that was provided by our Savior, Jesus. Let us celebrate His incarnation, His becoming a man, throughout this month. I hope you will prayerfully consider giving a gift in His honor to the Lottie Moon International Mission Offering that will be received throughout the month of December.
