I am excited about the Gospel to Every Home initiative that is motivating the body of Christ to mobilize and fulfill the Great Commission which is sharing the Gospel and endeavoring to bring people to Jesus Christ. We are presently sending teams out on Monday and Tuesday evenings at 6:30 p.m. and Saturdays at 10:30 a.m.. I hope that our members will support this emphasis in high numbers. The more involvement we have from our church body the easier it will be to cover our county. As we are going throughout the town and county, we are also looking forward to the ministry our team of nineteen will carry out while on missions in Kenai, Alaska, June 11-18. The team will be leading sport camps for several hundred children with the opportunity of sharing the Gospel as well as serving in the community on projects that open the doors for local churches to have inroads to minister to families. Our outreach this month will also include helping several of our KBC entities and a regional ministry that is on the frontlines of saving babies and ministering to dad's and moms in desperate situations. On Sunday, June 27 and July 4, we will receive our Blessings Offering for Clear Creek Baptist Bible College, Sunrise Children's Services, Oneida Baptist Institute, and Avenues for Women. The offering will be divided between the four ministries. Be in prayer for our group of twenty plus youth and adults heading to Crossings Summer Camp June 6-10 and our girls who will be a part of the G.A. Camp, June 22-24. We will finish the month supporting the Fairgrounds Service on Sunday evening June 27.
