#### Don't Miss Out!

The church family is finding great benefits and joy from involvement with the Gospel to Every Home. We are approaching a thousand homes that have been visited and should be there by the time this newsletter reaches you. This emphasis has moved our average weekly outreach attendance from three to five participants to nearly twenty-five a week. We have had over forty of our members that have gone on a soul-winning visit at least one time. Our prayer is that this number will continue to grow. The benefit to the participants has been a literal revival in their personal walk with Jesus. The conversations with our neighbors across the town and county has renewed focus on personal Bible study, increased the urgency and specificity in prayer, restored the joy of salvation which in turn impacts corporate worship, and has created a deep burden for those who are unsaved.

We were quite pleased with our first annual Sports Camp on July 19 and 20. We registered twenty-seven participants with most being from outside our church family. The camp focused on the basic fundamentals of basketball and the fundamentals of the faith in regard to salvation. The gospel was shared through an opening devotional time using an appropriate basketball emphasis that illustrated the concept and then re-enforced with an evangel cube during the twenty-minute faith station that each age group went through in their rotations. Our plans would be to build on this and to add the sport of archery next summer.

It has been a blessing to accomplish some needed updates around our facilities in the past few months. We have been able to completely re-pave the rest of our parking lots and to upgrade the flooring in our Youth Room. Your faithful giving has allowed us to do this debt-free! Our group of nine adults and children enjoyed a great camp experience at Crossings Camp July 23-26. The church family was able to encourage the ministries at Clear Creek, Oneida, Sunrise, and Avenues for Women through our annual Blessings Offering that allowed us to send each ministry a gift of \$1,500 during these summer months. Revival services are scheduled for October 31-November 3. Our evangelist will be Scott Newton Smith from Atlanta, Georgia and our music will be led by Dave Stahl. Begin praying daily for this special emphasis. While you are praying for a genuine revival for our church and spiritual awakening for our community, please pray that we as a body of Christ will have wisdom as we begin work with our Nominating Team to plan and structure our ministry in the year ahead. Consider what the Lord is leading you to do and be willing to step up and into that role.

It is certainly an exciting time as we consider that the fields are truly white unto harvest. Let us pray for more laborers to be sent into the fields and please be willing to say, "Lord, here am I, send me." Don't Miss Out on what the Lord is doing among us!
