Happiness in Jesus Sacrificed

My recent devotional reading in Judges reminded me of how dumb we are as humans. To be more precise it reminded me of what absolute morons we can be! The book of Judges reveals a terrible pattern and cycle practiced by God's covenant people. When they sought Him, trusted Him, and obeyed Him, they experienced blessings, liberty, and security. But they so often disregarded, doubted, and disobeyed Him and it led to bondage, hardship, and servitude.

Well, not much has changed when it comes to the people of God today. We may sing, "Trust and Obey for there's no other way to be happy in Jesus", but our practice is "Doubt and Disobey." We do not learn from the example of the covenant people in the past or even from our own experience in the present. We are so foolish in our choice to subjugate God to a secondary position in our lives. We must cease being afraid to activate a life that is totally yielded to following the ways of the Lord as delineated in His Word. Though the sacrifices will be many, they will be overwhelmingly rewarded by God. It is much better to feel the sting of sacrifice now and look back later with gratitude and joy for the Christ honoring decisions made. It is a much greater sacrifice to look back with regret for not having chosen the path that upholds the principles of His Word. Many a believer have succumbed to the pressure of the present, peers, personal pride, and the prevailing culture of our day. Tragically the choice of compromise, complacency, and neglect of God's purposes, plans, and priorities have not boded well for them individually, for their spouses, or for their children. The end result has been a tepid and often shipwrecked faith walk with Jesus. Make the decision now to "Trust and Obey" and follow His way no matter the sacrifice and you will find in the years ahead that it was best for you, your spouse, and your children.

I hope you will make every effort to be here for worship each Sunday as we continue our series on "Encounters with God" in the morning services and I Corinthians during the evening services. Decide now to involve your children and youth in Sunday School and bring your children to Team Kid and your youth to Main Street Students for the special Wednesday emphasis. Our Baptist Men and Baptist Women are involved in a great study once a month after the Family Night potluck meal. Our annual offering for North American Missions will be received on March 6 and 13. We will also begin hitting the country roads in Owen County to complete the Gospel to Every Home emphasis.
