Foundational Institution in Disarray

The month of May will be devoted to a focus on the family. We will celebrate our babies, our mother's, our graduates, our young adults, and our marriages. As we look across our nation, really across our county, we see the demise and destruction of the family unit. We have mutilated marriage by forsaking the Lord's standard that it is the coming together of one man and one woman and turned it into a laughingstock by calling everything under the sun a legitimate marriage.
