#### FROM YOUR PASTOR

"More, Please!"

Examine the phrase, "God will never put more on us than we can handle." This phrase erroneously developed from a misinterpretation of I Corinthian 10:13 that deals with temptation and the false assumption that we do not have the resources to resist them. Tragically the phrase has been applied to every challenge and struggle in life and many have become distraught and disillusioned when they face more than they can handle. So, why would God allow more to come upon us than we can handle? Let's allow the apostle Paul to answer this question with the response he makes in II Corinthians 12:9-10, "And He said to me, My grace is sufficient for you, for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Therefore, most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore, I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak then I am strong." Do you see it? When the struggles, challenges, and needs are greater than any resource we have, they cause us to come to the end of ourselves and our strength. This "giving up" allows a death to self to happen and then we have nothing to depend on but the Lord, which is what He always desires. God wants our dependence to be totally in Him and not in ourselves. Depending completely on Him is realizing that it is His grace that sustains us and not our resolve and His strength and not our might. Our acknowledgment of weakness is how His strength is released, and our admitting that we cannot releases His power. When we experience the blessing of having more on us than we can handle, we then move into the reality of His blessings that leads us to literally boast in weakness and take pleasure in infirmities. So, let's thank the Lord for the "more than we can handle."
