#### Rubbish Removed

Our recent study in II Chronicles 29 brought us to an interesting command from Hezekaih, King of Judah, in verse 5. The scripture says, "Hear me, Levites! Now sanctify yourselves, sanctify the house of the LORD God of your fathers, and carry out the *rubbish* from the holy place." They were to cleanse themselves and the place of worship. This is a reminder to us that the man and woman of God should be right with God and the house of God should be right. The messenger and the message ought to be right, but we should also make certain that the method is right. Do the right thing and do it the right way. There is a need for order in our lives and order in our worship, methods, and ministries. The chapter reveals that once the cleansing was completed it led to service, singing, and sacrifice. They participated in ministry, praised with music and song, and provided material means. It would do us good to remove the *rubbish* from our bodily temple through cleansing repentance with these same results to follow.


There is much happening this month, and it will take many of us to step up and serve to accomplish the ministry before us.


