## OWEN COUNTY CHURCH LEAGUE Co-ed Volleyball League Rules

Each team must have at least six members on the team roster.
Each team must have five players to play a match.
At least TWO females must be on the floor at all times.
All players must be at least 12 years of age.
A ball must be returned with no more than three hits.
Substitutions are made at the serving position.
Scoring is based on the Rally Point System. Points are awarded on every play.
A point is awarded to the team that wins a particular rally.
Games are played to 25. If the score is 24-24 the game will continue until one
team has a two-point advantage (e.g. 27-25).
If the ball hits the net on the serve it is "in play," just as if it were to hit the net in
the middle of a rally.
All matches are the best two out of three games. Every team will play three
games on a scheduled night even if the match has already been decided after
two games.
No one may be added to a team roster after the sixth week of play.
For a player to be eligible to compete in tournament play he/she must have
participated in at least one match prior to the tournament.
If a player arrives after a game has already begun he/she must wait until the
next game to play.
If the ball hits the ceiling and crosses over to the other side of the court, it is
considered a dead ball and a point is awarded to the other team. If the ball hits
the ceiling and remains on the same side of the court, the ball is still in play.
If the ball hits the backboard or walking track, it is considered a dead ball and a
point is awarded to the other team.
"Spiking" is allowed, but no part of your body may touch the net when doing so.
You cannot spike on a serve.
Contact with the ball using your foot is not allowed.
Switching is not allowed.
All other rules are the same as those of the United States Volleyball Association.
