When we consider our Saviors path to Calvary, we see that it was littered with failure, denial, and even a traitor among those who were closest to Jesus. Imagine the agony of soul that brought to Him. However, Jesus had made it clear that He did not entrust Himself to those who believed in Him since He knew what was in man. (John 2:24-25)

Greg Koukl gives great insight on what to do when our heroes fall and fail. Consider these suggestions: Guard Your Own Soul

When your hero falls do not dig for details. Sin is a dirty, deadly thing that harms us the deeper we get into the details.

Don't Be Surprised when a Sinner Sins

You might be shocked initially but you should not be shaken. Ultimately there is only one that is good and that is Jesus.

The Truth is still the Truth

The sound, truthful things your fallen hero shared are still sound and truthful.

Do not Become Cynical

Do not allow the failure of this highly regarded one cause you to be suspicious of others. When you wonder who you can trust, trust everyone you have no reason to mistrust. Resolve to Finish Well

Jesus did not let the fall and failure of those nearest Him to impede His finishing the work He came to accomplish. We must not allow the failures of others to hinder our finishing well. The Resurrection of Jesus makes all this possible.

Heavenly Sunlight was written by Henry J. Zelley in 1899, and it's one of those hymns that stays with you, reminding us of the bright, constant presence of Christ. The chorus says, "Heavenly sunlight, heavenly sunlight, flooding my soul with glory divine." Just as the sun's warmth fills the air around us, God's light fills our hearts and lives, offering peace and warmth we can't find anywhere else.

In John 8:12 (CSB), Jesus tells us, "I am the light of the world. Anyone who follows me will never walk in the darkness but will have the light of life." Think about that for a moment. Jesus is the light that guides our way, and when we follow Him, we never have to stumble in the darkness. No matter how cloudy life may seem, His light is always shining.

The Bible also reminds us in 1 John 1:5 (CSB), "This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light, and there is absolutely no darkness in him." That's good news for us! In a world that can often

feel uncertain, we know that God's light is unshakable and never fades. It's always shining, even when we can't see it through the clouds.
